# Stonehenge



- Found on England's Salisbury Plain in Wiltshire around 1,500BC, Stonehenge is a huge man-made circle of standing stones
- Work started on this super stone circle around 5,000 years ago in the late Neolithic Age – but it took over 1,000 years to build, in four long stages!
- A legend claimed giants placed the monument on a mountain in Ireland, before a wizard named Merlin magically moved the stone circle to England
