

Crowdfunder exists to **tackle society's challenges** by **making ideas happen**.

Every day, **up to 300** crowdfunding projects are added to the site. To date **£270m** has been raised and at any time a match funding pot of **£millions** is available.

Crowdfunder fees

Always check up to date fees at crowdfunder.co.uk/fees

• Platform fee

- For-profit projects = 5% + VAT
- Not-for profit/Charities = 0%

• Transaction fee

- 2.4% of total pledged + 20p per pledge + VAT
- Charities = 1.9% + 20p per pledge + VAT
- +Extra Funding fee
 - Generally 5% + VAT for any +Extra Funding you receive from our partners
- If the project owner is VAT registered, they can claim it back
- Monies raised are paid into the nominated bank account, minus the fees, within 7 working days
